MESSAGE FROM QUINCY BENBOW

Dear Friends and Supporters,

As Chair of the Board of On-Ramps to Careers, I am proud to share with you the tremendous impact we have achieved together in 2023. This year has been one of remarkable growth and accomplishment, underscored by our steadfast commitment to empowering young people through education and career opportunities in the technology sector.

In 2023, we welcomed 240 high school interns from 23 DC high schools and 51 college interns from 33 colleges and universities, a testament to our expanding reach and influence. Our programs continue to open doors for traditionally marginalized youth, helping them to build the skills and networks necessary for successful careers in STEM fields. The diversity of our interns reflects our commitment to inclusivity: 77% identified as African American/Black, 10% as Hispanic, and 7% as mixed race, among others.

Our partnerships with local high schools, colleges, employers, and community organizations have been pivotal. This year, we have seen a significant increase in non-profit foundation grants and contributions, with a 57% rise compared to last year. Additionally, our government grants nearly doubled, reinforcing the value and trust that our community places in our mission.

One of our proudest moments was honoring our outstanding alumni, India Brown and Josue Castillo, with the "Alumni of the Year" award. Their achievements underscore the lasting impact of our programs and the bright futures our interns can achieve.

Looking forward, we are excited to continue building on this momentum. Our goals for 2024 include expanding our internship programs, enhancing our professional development workshops, and increasing our outreach to engage more students and partners.


